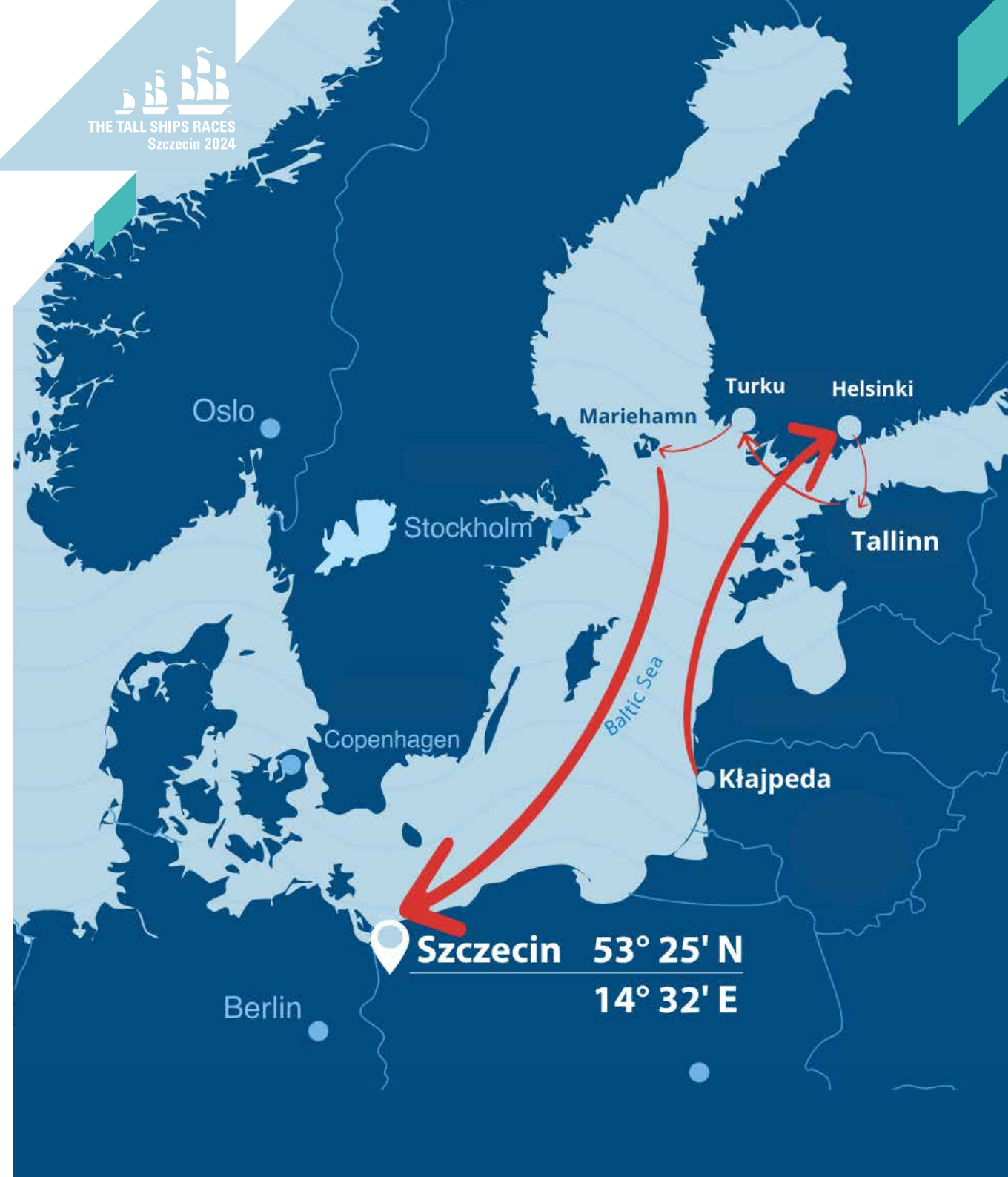

ABOUT THE REGATTA

After a seven-year break, the Tall Ships return to Szczecin. Before we welcome the international sailing crews at the base of the Chrobry Embankment and play their flags' national anthems, they will have to compete in a regatta. The Tall Ships regatta will begin in Klaipeda. This is the point from which the vessels will set sail to Helsinki, where the first part of the race officially finishes and at the same time the first friendship race to Tallinn begins. Tallinn will also be the start of the second part of the race, which will finish in Turku. There will be two friendship races this year, the second one on the Turku–Marienhamn route. The last and the longest stage of the regatta, with the grand finale in Szczecin, will take place between Marienhamn and Szczecin.

The start list is continuing to grow with fresh applications, and there are still 5 months left until the start of the regatta! Our organisers are carefully watching the submissions, and by the end of January there were over 60 of them! Eight A-class sailing vessels have already confirmed their participation.

Others who have confirmed their presence in Szczecin are some of the international celebrities. For the first time, the Guayas ship will dock by the Chrobry Embankment. This Ecuadorian barque is nearly 79 metres long! In 2007, the crew of this barque won the highest recognition in the Mediterranean edition of the Tall Ships Races – the Friendship Trophy, awarded by secret voting of the captains. The next exotic guest is already well-known in Szczecin, the Brazilian white swan – the Cisne Branco. Amongst other international guests, we may also find the German sailing ship, Grossherzogin Elisabeth. There will also be Polish representatives as well. Dar Młodzieży and Kapitan Głowacki will be celebrating the finish of the regatta together with us.

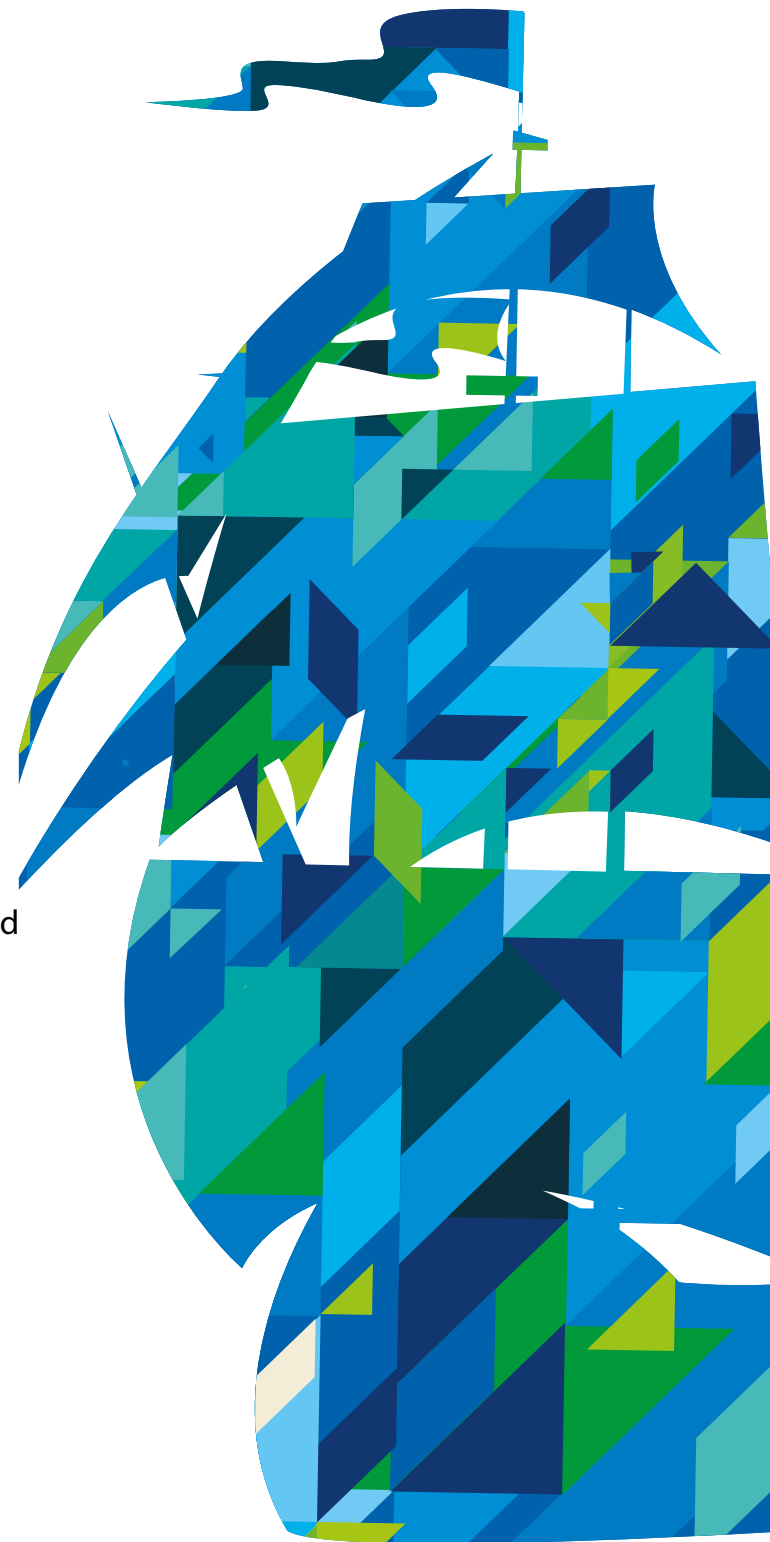

EXPERIENCE A THRILLING SAILING ADVENTURE

Taking part in the Tall Ships Races regatta and racing amongst the largest sailing ships in the world is all within hand's reach! Enrolment for the Szczecin team is open until the **29th of February**. Three Szczecin yachts will be setting sail in two-stage regatta: Dar Szczecina, Zryw and Urtica.

Young sailors can race in two stages:

- I (22/06/2024–13/07/2024) Szczecin (Poland) – Klaipeda (Lithuania) – Helsinki (Finland) – Tallin (Estonia)
- II (13/07/2024–05/08/2024) Tallin (Estonia) – Turku (Finland) – Mariehamn (Aland Islands) – Szczecin (Poland)

To become a member of the Szczecin Sailing Team you have to: be 18 years old by 20/06/2024, live, study or work in Poland, be a creative person who is not afraid of challenges, and know at least one foreign language at a communicative level.



ORGANISE THIS EVENT WITH US!

On August 2-5, Łasztownia in Szczecin and the Chrobry Embankment will be the places where sailors will be leading the way. Vessels from around the world will be arriving in Szczecin. This is why we need liaison officers (volunteers) and other volunteers for handling the event in terms of supporting the organiser in the coordination of all the activities.
